General & Camping Rules

- With 60 acres and over 600 oak trees, there is sure to be a great place and plenty of room for everyone to setup a spacious camp.
- Everyone is welcome at the ranch and we strive to maintain a family atmosphere, so please respect others during your stay. Due to natural environment please do not leave small children unattended.
- As a guest at the Melody Oaks Ranch you are responsible for your actions, Melody Oaks Ranch is not responsible for accidents during your stay.
- No ground fires are allowed, campfires are allowed but only when built in an approved containment device (Examples are - concrete fire ring, barrel, etc.....). You must bring your own wood, there will be no cutting down trees or brush.
- No ATV's, 4-wheelers, or other motorized vehicle use is allowed on Melody Oaks Ranch grounds except by Melody Oaks Ranch officials and authorized tractor pull contestants (use will be restricted to the pit area only).
- No unleashed pets allowed.
- Generators are allowed, but we do ask that you respect your neighbors. Generators will only be allowed in designated areas only.
- No glass bottles.
- No small children left unattended
- No parking outside the Melody Oaks Ranch grounds.
- No obscene signs, banners, or slogans.
- Please put trash in trashcans, you found it clean, please help us keep it that way.
- Only 1 vehicle will be allowed at each campsite.
