HEALTH & SAFETY REGULATIONS

- Handwashing Stations Provided By City
- Ensure All Meat Is Kept On Ice Until Cooked
- Cooks Must Wear Food Handling Gloves When Preparing Donated Brisket
- Cooks Must Wash Hands Between Handling Raw And Cooked Meat
- Cooks Must Wear Ball Caps Or Hair Nets When Handling Donated Brisket
- Cooks Must Utilize Two Tongs — One Each For Raw And Cooked Meats
