1. Teams can start checking in at 3:00 pm Thursday March 10th, pits may be dropped off at this time. (There will be no security for pits dropped off early)
2. Each team **MUST** check in by 8:00am Saturday March 12th, all entry fees must be paid at time of check in.
3. A tray pick up form must be completed at check in to receive your trays.
4. Cooks meeting TBD, will advise at check in. (Friday 7pm or Saturday 9am)
5. An entry fee of \$175 is required for all meat categories (brisket, ribs, chicken); a \$20 entry fee is required for each additional category (Jackpot Beans, Margaritas) All Lone Star Barbecue Society Rules will apply to meat and Jackpot entries.
6. Ribs must show a cut bone end, can be St Louis style. (No baby backs, loin backs, or country style)
7. Chicken must be fully jointed, split chicken. Must include a breast portion, leg, thigh, wing (with or without tip) and skin.
8. Beans must be dry pinto
9. Barbeque will be judged on texture, moisture, tenderness, aroma, and taste. The decision of the judges are **FINAL**.
10. Contest committeemen reserve the right to make additional regulation as situations warrant.

Judging times are as follows:

Margaritas	8:00pm Friday 3/11
Beans	11:00am Saturday 3/12
Chicken	NOON Saturday 3/12
Ribs	1:30pm Saturday 3/12
Brisket	3:00pm Saturday 3/12
Awards	Saturday 3/12 (time TBD based on judging above)
