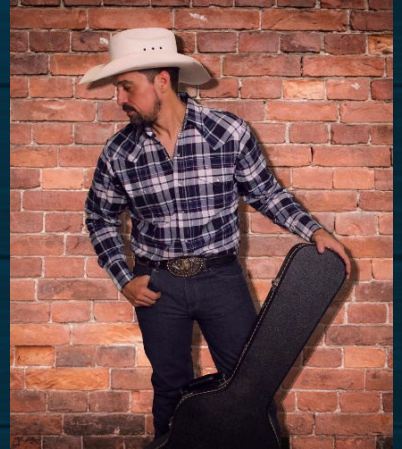

September 13 & 14, 2019

- **No Refunds On Registration Fees:** All registration money received will be used for the cost of event, and provided to the fundraiser recipient.
- **Registration:** Space is limited, and based on a first-come/first-serve basis. Sites will be assigned in the order of complete registration & payment being received.
- **Boundaries:** BBQ pits and campers (including hitch) must fit into space provided. Each registration includes (1)30*30 space.
- **Parking:** Vehicles must be parked in designated parking area.
- **Equipment:** Cookers are responsible for all needed equipment and supplies; including but not limited to electricity, and water.
- **Set-up:** Begins Friday, September 13, 11am.
- **Check-in:** Contestants must be checked in no later than 7pm Friday, September 13.
- **Closed Entrance:** For safety reasons the grounds will be closed, & vehicles will not be permitted after 8pm, Friday, September 13.
- **Restroom Facilities:** The establishment does *NOT* have outdoor restroom facilities for teams to use after hours. The event committee will make arrangements for a minimum of 2 port-a-potties to be available for 24 hour use by anyone on location Friday - Sunday.
 - Your team may reserve a port-a-potty specifically for your team by making the selection on the registration form and adding the rental fee to your total registration fee. Port-a-potties will be delivered & placed Thursday evening, and picked up on Monday morning.
 - If you are reserving a personal port-a-potty you must provide a photo or sketch of your area set-up, include dimensions, and identify which side will be set-up for cooking. This is necessary to help the event committee to properly place the port-a-potty in your space.
- **Noise Restriction:** 12:00am-6am. No loud parties after midnight. No loud music anytime.
- **Trash:** Teams are responsible for cleanup of their space. Dumpsters are provided. Please bring your own trash bags. Do not dump grease, coals, or ashes on the ground; properly extinguish and place in the provided dumpsters.
- **Miscellaneous:**
 - Pets are not allowed
 - Firearms, swords, throwing blades, or any other type of illegal weapons, & illegal substances are prohibited.

Alcohol Policy:

- Teams may bring their own alcohol. Alcohol not purchased from the establishment may not be carried or consumed inside of the building. Taking personal drinks (not purchased from the establishment) inside the building will be grounds for team disqualification.
- The chief cook of each team will be held responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guests.
- Please be mindful of this being a family oriented event by refraining from loud, offensive noise or language.
- Excessive use of alcohol or fighting will be grounds for team disqualification and offending participants will immediately be escorted off of the property.
- Glass bottles, and containers are prohibited.
- Team's alcohol beverages are limited to team consumption only and not to be given away to visitors.
- Anyone consuming alcohol on-site must be at least 21 years of age. Underage drinking is prohibited and will be grounds for team disqualification.

The event committee, organizers, participants, the establishment owner(s), staff, and affiliates are not held responsible for accidents, lost or damaged property, or personal injury.

Each team assumes all risks & hazards incidental to participation in the event. Registered teams waive, release, absolve, and agree to hold harmless the event committee, organizers, participants, the establishment owner(s), staff, and affiliates for any claim arising out of said participation at the event.

September 13 & 14, 2019

Rules & Guidelines:

- **Meat Categories:** Brisket, Spare Pork Ribs, & Chicken. Teams may choose to participate in any or all of the meat categories.
- **Meat Inspection Time:** tbd. All meat will be brought to the site RAW. Meat preparation must be done on the grounds of the cook-off. No pre-marinating, pre-soaking, or pre-spicing of meat prior to inspection. Meat may be trimmed. No meat will be allowed to leave the site after it has been inspected.
- **Cooking-Meats:** Teams may use any type of barbecue pit or smoker they choose. All meats must be cooked over wood or wood substance fire. Holes or dug out pits are not permitted.
- **Cooking-Additional Categories:** Beans, Cajun Creation, Kid's Make'n Bacon, & Salsa are allowed on a burner.
 - **Kid's Make'n Bacon:** Must be cooked on-site with the direct supervision of 1 adult team cook. Team cook may not assist with preparation, plating, or turning into judges. Any main dish, side dish, appetizer, or dessert with bacon in the recipe may be used. Bacon must be included in the dish, and not used as a topping or garnish.
- **Cook's Meeting:** Friday, September 13, 7pm sharp. Each team's Chief Cook must attend, & bring the judging forms. Judging trays will be issued. Judging area will be announced.
- **Turn-in Quantities:** Cooks are to turn in 7 slices of brisket, approximately 1/4"-3/4" thick with the ends of the brisket attached. Cooks are to turn in 7 pork spare ribs, St. Louis style is okay. No baby backs or country style. Cooks are to turn in 2 chicken halves. Additional categories; Beans, Cajun Creation, Salsa, Kid Cooks and supervising cook are to turn in quantities will be announced at the cooks meeting.

Turn-in Times: 10am - Salsa / **11am** - Kid's Make'n Bacon / **12 Noon** - Cajun Creation / **1pm** - Beans / **2pm** - Chicken / **3pm** - Pork Spare Ribs/ **4pm** - Brisket

*Turn-in times are subject to change based on the final number of registrations. Final turn-in times will be announced at the cooks meeting.

- **Turn-in Times:** Teams are responsible for delivering their entry to the Judging Area. There will be a 20 minute window for turn-in. Meaning you will have 10 minutes before and 10 minutes after the designated turn in time to deliver your entry to the Judging Area.
- **Marking & Garnish:** Cooks may cook with sauce however when preparing meat for turn in nothing may be added to the meat in the tray. Cooks will be asked to correct their tray if sauce or juice is added to the meat in the tray. Nothing should puddle in the tray. Any and all garnishes are prohibited.
- **Awards Ceremony:** Will be held Saturday, September 14, from the main stage once judging is complete.

Meat: Grand Champion- Free entry for a future HONOR cook-off event & an award banner,

Reserve Grand Champion- \$100 cash & award banner,

1st- Cash & award banner, 2nd- Cash, 3rd- Cash

Kid's Make'n Bacon: 1st- trophy, 2nd- trophy, 3rd- trophy

Beans: 1st- Cash & award banner, 2nd- Cash

Cajun Creation, & Salsa (awarded separately): 1st- Cash & award banner

People's Choice (awarded separately): 1st- Cash & award banner

Peoples Choice Rules & Guidelines:

- Teams may register up to a Total of four food items for the Peoples Choice category.
- A separate registration fee is applicable for each food item.
- **Food Choices:** Protein or Dessert. You may register any combination of proteins or desserts, up to a Total of 4 items./team (ex: 2 protein/2 dessert; or 1 protein/3 dessert. NOT 4 protein/4 dessert.)
- Selected food item must be included on the registration form.
- Food items must be cooked on-site. Bringing in outside, prepped, or pre-cooked/baked dishes is not allowed.
- Teams are responsible for supplies required to provide samples to the public.
- Peoples Choice participants will receive a voting ticket container, and flier at check-in to display for the public to easily identify who they may sample with.
- The provided voting ticket container must be used, and may not be substituted or altered.
- The public will have the option to purchase a wristband from the Event Staff to sample food items registered for the Peoples Choice category.
- Attendees who purchase an event wristband will be given voting tickets.
- Teams may only provide samples of the food item registered for the category to attendees with an event wristband.
- Allowing those without an event wristband to sample will lead to disqualification in the Peoples Choice category.
- Be prepared to provide samples to the public between the hours of **10am-3pm on Saturday, September 14.**
- Although it is recommended to have the opportunity to collect as many votes as possible, teams are *not* required to provide samples during all five hours.
- Allowing sampling before 10am, or after 3pm will be grounds for disqualification from the category.
- Votes are collected by attendees dropping their ticket(s) in the event ticket container for the team food item of their choice.
- Attendees with an event wristband may purchase additional voting tickets.
- Voting ticket containers must be turned in Saturday, September 14 by 3:30pm.
- Voting tickets will be tallied & the Peoples Choice winner will be determined by the team/food item with the highest number of voting tickets collected in their event ticket container.
- 1st place will be announced for each; Protein & Dessert.
