The Chief Cook's meeting will be held at the Marge Rosenburg Stage Saturday, September 5th At 6:00 PM followed by a Calcutta auction at 6:30

Rules:

- 1. Teams will consist of a Chief Cook and team members
- Cookers may enter the grounds on September 3rd & 4th
- The categories to be judged: Beef Brisket, Pork Butt, Pork Spare/St. Louis Ribs, Chicken, Pinto Beans & Side Dish. Side Dish is just that - no meat or dessert - must be a vegetable (adding bacon, ham, etc. is Okay, just just can't be the main ingredient).
- Meat tag-in will begin at 10am Saturday, September 5th. At the time of check in, meat MUST be raw, thawed and unseasoned.
- Judging Saturday September 5th: Pinto Beans, 4pm,; Side Dish. 5pm,; Chief Cooks Meeting, 6pm; Calcutta Auction, 6:30 pm
- Judging Sunday, September 6th: Chicken, 11:00am., Pork Butt, 1:00pm, Pork Ribs, 2:00pm and Brisket, 3:30pm Tentative time for results announcements is 5:00pm at Marge Rosenburg Stage
- 7. A 25' x 25' space is available for each team: BBQ pits and campers ONLY (must fit into space provided).
- 8. Cookers are responsible for all needed equipment and supplies.
- THE FAYETTE COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE THE THEFT AND/OR DAMAGE TO EQUIPMENT OF CONTESTANTS (PITS, VEHICLES, CAMPERS, ETC.).
- Fires must be of wood or wood substances. NO electric or gas fires will be allowed (ONLY beans will allow a burner). Holes or dug pits are NOT permitted.
- 11. The CHIEF COOK of each team will be held responsible for the conduct of his/her guest and team members. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages or fighting <u>WILL BE GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION and will be</u> asked to leave the premises without refunds.
- 12. Calcutta rules: The Calcutta auction will follow the Chief Cook's meeting at the Marge Rosenburg Stage on Saturday September 5th at 6:30pm. Teams will have first option to buy their team for \$200.00, if they decline, bidding will start at \$20.00 per team with no maximum. The Calcutta pay out will be divided evenly between the purchaser of the team winning overall in all the meats and the Fayette County Fair Association. If the winning team is not purchased in the Calcutta auction, the Fayette County Fair Association will keep the Calcutta money.
- Entries must be received by September 5th before check in)ONLY the first 50 PAID entries will be allowed).
- Cash awards and trophies will be given in each category: Pinto beans, beef ribs, chicken, pork ribs and beef brisket.
- 15. Contestant committeemen reserve the right to make additional rules as situations warrant. Decisions of the committee chairman and judges are final.
- 16. Curfew will be in effect: no loud music or parties after 12:00am.
- 17. ONE VEHICLE AND ONE ATV, GOLF CARTS ARE ALLOWED IN COOK OFF AREA
- 18. No animals.
- 19. No firearms or glass containers allowed
